

Vietnam Veterans Thank You Card From America Campaign

The Vietnam War ended after ten years on April 30, 1975. Nearly 2.6 million Americans served. More than one in ten were wounded and over 58,000 killed. Fewer than 900,000 are alive today. Some 1,700 POW/MIA are still unaccounted for.

Unlike past wars, our returning troops never received the warm welcome they deserved, but rather silence, shame or hostility. Some were even spit on. **Few ever heard the words, "thank you."**

It is time to correct this injustice and heal this national wound—especially while many Vietnam veterans are still alive. That is why Veterans in Defense of Liberty (VIDOL) launched its two-year **"Vietnam Veterans Thank You Card From America"** campaign.

Official Thank You cards will go to millions of Americans to sign and return, then be presented on Memorial Day 2015 at the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Wall by a civilian delegation to a delegation of Vietnam veterans. Cards will be displayed at the Memorial, then permanently archived.

The names of all signers will be printed, alphabetically by state, on a HUGE permanent Thank You Card large enough for millions of names. The goal is to set an **Official World Record** with the most names ever listed on a single greeting card.

Those who donate \$20 or more will be listed, alphabetically by state, in a Memorial Day 2014 Insert of *The Washington Times* going to the President, the Joint Chiefs of Staff, every member of

the 114th Congress, and entered into the official Congressional Record.
